Call to Order:

Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Director Horn

- 1. Approval of Agenda Items: Agenda was approved.
- 2. Public Comment and/or Communication: None.
- 3. Approval of O&S Summary Minutes for July 2, 2010: Minutes were approved.
- 4. Maintenance:
  - a) Quitclaim for Sewer Line Mr. Mitchell explained that the right of way over the sewer line had never been deeded to CCCTA upon completion of the facility construction. The Contra Costa County Sanitary District retained ownership and an easement. To correct this oversight the Board needs to approve a quitclaim resolution. There was discussion about the location of the line and the fact that it had been confirmed that the sewer line was in good condition. The Committee approved staff recommendation to send the quitclaim resolution to the Board.
  - b) Access Control Project Mr. Mitchell explained that the replacement of door hardware and locks is part of a federal homeland security project that is funded with a grant for \$319,320. The new access control project entails the installation of proximity card readers and the system being recommended is sold by Siemans through the State CMAS contract. There was discussion about the benefits of a proximity card system over the current locks. The Committee approved staff recommendation.
  - c) <u>Leased Tires and Related Services Contract</u> Mr. Mitchell explained that a request for bids had been issued that Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company was the successful (and only) bidder. Their price was deemed fair and reasonable. The Committee discussed why only one bid was received and the structure of the contract. The Committee supported staff recommendation to award.
- 5. Planning and Scheduling:
  - a) Service to Cal State East Bay: Ms. Muzzini presented a service plan whereby the route 98X would be eliminated and a new route to CSU would be created using the same number of hours. This plan was developed to satisfy the requirements of MTC to keep RM2 funding. The Committee supported staff's recommendation to conduct a public hearing on the elimination of the 98X route. Mr. Horn asked that maps be brought to the next meeting that show the service area of the 98X, the new CSU route, and possible options for the #25.
- 6. Paratransit and Accessible Services: None

- 7. Staff Reports Fixed Route and LINK Operating Summary Statistics
  - a. Fixed Route Reports July 2010: The reports were reviewed and discussed.

SUBJECT: Route #25 Re-Route

#### SUMMARY OF ISSUES: Background

In March of 2009 County Connection reduced overall service by 23% and re-structured many routes as well. Service that functioned as special school routes were separated from the regular schedule. The old routes #206 and #106 were converted to "school routes" and service during non school times which was unproductive was eliminated. In part, to compensate for this change, a new route, the Route #25, was crafted that would serve Mt. Diablo Blvd. and provide Lafayette businesses in this corridor transit service.

#### Performance

The Route #25 has not performed well since the beginning. The number of passengers carried per hour is the lowest in the system. Ridership patterns have been analyzed and most passengers are boarding and alighting at the BART station in Lafayette and the BART station in Walnut Creek and not at the stops in between. The CCCTA Operations and Scheduling Committee wanted to give this route time to catch on and there was hope that the new Library opening would attract more riders. Ridership has remained very low with an average weekday ridership of 40 and productivity of 3.6 passengers per hour.

#### Options and Public Comment


The Operations and Scheduling Committee of the CCCTA Board has directed staff to consider a routing change to attract more riders. A public hearing/ workshop will be conducted on 9/30/2010 to gather input on routing options which include running the bus on local streets between Pleasant Hill Road and the Walnut Creek BART station.

SUBJECT: Elimination of #98 and implementation of new route to CSU

#### SUMMARY OF ISSUES:

A proposal was discussed at the last O&S meeting whereby a new route would be developed to serve the Cal State Unniversity East Bay (CSU) campus using the service hours currently used on the 98X.

The most productive corridor for a new route to CSU is Clayton Road and routing along this corridor has the best chance of meeting the farebox recovery criteria for continued RM2 funding. Staff has developed a schedule for the new route that uses the same number of hours as the 98X. Details are shown below:

First trip departs BART Concord at 7:15am

Last trip departs CSU at 10:12pm

Headways: 30 minute in the peak and 60 minute mid-day and

late night

A public hearing was held for this new route, (then called the 10X) in January. On 9/28/2010 a public hearing was held on the elimination of the 98X. Comments received will be presented at the Committee meeting.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:** 

Staff recommends that the Committee consider public comment. then decide whether or not to support a plan to eliminate the 98X and replace it with a new route connecting BART Concord to

CSU via Clayton Road.



SUBJECT: West Dublin BART Station Opening and Service Change Timing

SUMMARY OF ISSUES:

The West Dublin BART station is expected to be open in February 2011. The opening presents an opportunity to consider re-routing the #35, #36, and #97X service that currently terminate at the Dublin BART station. At this point information is being gathered about ridership patterns and in the case of the #97X commuter connections at the existing Dublin station.

Staff would like to get Committee concurrence that any route changes that will be made as a result of the West Dublin opening will not occur until the Spring bid period which will be March 20, 2011. In the meantime the committee will have time to review ridership data, Bishop Ranch and San Ramon input, and to conduct public hearings on any route changes desired.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:** 

Staff recommends that the Committee support timing any route changes precipitated by the West Dublin station opening at the beginning of the Spring bid.



#### Analysis

Average weekday ridership in August (10,763 passengers) is slightly higher than the July ridership of 10,662 per average weekday. See the attached table showing weekday boardings trend. Productivity in August was equal to 14.7 passengers per hour as compared to July's figure of 14.3 passengers per hour. The most productive routes remain the #20, #4, #10, and the 600 series of school tripper routes. A table showing the ranking of route by productivity is attached.

The percentage of missed trips was down in August to 0.06% from the prior month of 0.09% in July, but well within the goal set by the Board (0.25%). The YTD average is 0.08% missed trips.

The number of miles between roadcalls was equal to 32,860 miles which is higher than prior month and the year to date average of 27,908 miles between roadcalls.
