SUBJECT: Concord Pavilion Service

SUMMARY OF ISSUES:

Last year the Board authorized entering into an agreement with LIVE NATION for the Sleep Train Pavilion concert bus service. The A&F Committee recommended a premium fare of \$5 per round trip and the final board action set a LIVE Nation price of \$1,600 per concert. This memo is to report on last year's service as well as report on the 2011 Summer Concert series.

For the 2011 Concert Series, a private charter company expressed interest in providing the service, and per FTA Charter Regulations, County Connection is no longer allowed to pursue a contract with LIVE NATION for the upcoming concert series.
