**SUBJECT:** Fluid Applied Roofing Contract

#### BACKGROUND:

The Central Contra Costa Transit Authority constructed its facilities at 2477 Arnold Industrial Way in 1986. After 26 years, time has taken its toll on the building roof and trim, and the time has come to replace the coating.

#### SUMMARY OF ISSUES:

The Authority has issued an Invitation For Bids (IFB) for an Applied Roofing Contract. Bid packages were offered to contractors who have a verified history of doing Fluid Applied Roofing Contracts. The roof coating process that Staff has selected is Eco friendly as it will provide additional insulation in both hot and cold seasons. The bid was advertised in the Contra Costa Times twice and with the Builders Exchange of Concord California. A pre-bid conference was held to allow bidders the opportunity to survey the existing conditions and understand the complexity of the job requirements. At the bid opening on May 20, 2011 at 2:00pm, four (4) bids were received from interested contractors. The four (4) bids received were 1) SLR Solano County Roofing \$613,700 2) Western Roofing Services \$499,241 3) ARC Andy's Roofing Corp. \$216,976 and D.C. Taylor Co. \$185,486. The apparent low bidder was D.C. Taylor Co. Staff has determined that the low bid is responsive and that the bidder is technically responsible to perform the required work.

#### **OPTION 1:**

The O&S committee recommends that the CCCTA Board award a contract to D.C. Taylor Co. for the coating contract.

#### **OPTION 2:**

The O&S Committee direct staff to re-advertise the procurement.

#### **OPTION 3:**

The O&S Committee recommend to not award a contract.

#### FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

The Authority has approved grant funds available for this project. Funds are available from Grant (Fed) CA-09-Y037 in the amount of \$148,486 and Grant 10-0011-01 (TDA) in the amount of \$37,121. The combined total of \$185,607 will sufficiently fund the entire coating project. The A&F Committee has previously approved the funding source for this project.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS:

Staffs recommends that the O&S Committee recommend award of a contract to D.C. Taylor Co. for the replacement of coatings for the four (4) buildings.

#### ACTION REQUESTED:

The O&S Committee recommend to the Board of Directors at its June 16, 2011 meeting, the award of a contract by CCCTA to D.C. Taylor Co. for the replacement covering for the four buildings..

SUBJECT: Bus Shelters Status Report

#### SUMMARY OF ISSUES:

Advertising versus Non Advertising: Bus shelters within Cities with an advertising contract (CBS Outdoor) have shelters installed and maintained by the contractor in trade for ad revenues. The following jurisdictions have ad contracts:

Martinez

Pleasant Hill

Concord

Contra Costa County

San Ramon

Walnut Creek - council approval; in negotiation

<u>CCCTA Owned:</u> The first shelters purchased by CCCTA were the concrete and steel "bunker" style and many of these are still in service. CCCTA later installed some aluminum shelters. In all cases, whether CBS or CCCTA owned, shelters are maintained through a contract between CBS and the Regional Center.

Recent Activities: The planning staff has developed a funding proposal for a bus stop access project whereby locations would be selected for improvements whether sidewalk, shelter, or information. The Caltrans planning funds (\$90,000) would pay for the design of access projects for as many as 50 stop locations. The specific project designs could then be used to support construction grant opportunities. Potentially Measure J funds for livable communities could be used to make transit access improvements.

In addition to setting the stage for transit access improvement grants, staff has been working to develop the Top 25 bus stops list. Stops are ranked by the number of boardings per day and do not include BART stations. The stops have been analyzed to determine what improvements need to be made, and in some cases there are steps within our control. In some cases this means working with the jurisdiction and CBS to get an ad shelter placed at the stop.

The City of Walnut Creek has decided to pursue an advertising contract and once completed, old shelters will be replaced with new ones that feature solar powered lighting.

SUBJECT: Community Van Program

#### SUMMARY OF ISSUES:

The Community Van Program was developed as a way to support nonprofit community agencies that provide transportation to ADA eligible riders. Used vans were given to agencies through a process that ensured that they were able to provide insurance, maintain it, and certification that they were providing trips to individuals who would be LINK riders otherwise.

<u>Board authorization</u>: The general manager was authorized to implement the community van program in Resolution 2006-025 which is attached.

<u>Vans available:</u> Staff has analyzed the forty two vans due for replacement and has picked the ten in the best condition. Mileage on the selected vehicles range from 198,000 to 270,000 miles.

<u>Funding:</u> There is a grant (Lifeline) approved to fund maintenance expenses incurred by agencies for these vans, however the match requirement is 50%. In 20006 agencies were given a \$5,000 credit paid on a reimbursement method.

Agencies: These successfully met the requirements in the 2006 program: Mt. Diablo Rehab., City of San Ramon Senior Center, City of Lafayette Senior Transportation Project, and the Contra Costa ARC (Assoc. of Retarded Citizens).

#### Process:

- 1) Staff will solicit applications (attached) from Community Based Organizations. Applications will be evaluated in terms of the criteria of the program:
  - Financial capacity and ability to operate the vehicle
  - Service to ADA rider population
  - Willingness to sign certifications and assurances
- 2) Review of applications at staff, and advisory committee level.
- 3) Board award and contract approval

#### RECOMMENDATIONS:

Staff recommends that the O&S Committee support implementation of the 2011 Community Van Program and that ten 2002 retired vans be made available.

### AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM FOR USE OF SURPLUS LINK VANS BY COMMUNITY BASED PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the County of Contra Costa and the Cities of Clayton, Concord, the Town of Danville, Lafayette, Martinez, the Town of Moraga, Orinda, Pleasant Hill, San Ramon and Walnut Creek (hereinafter "Member Jurisdictions") have formed the Central Contra Costa Transit Authority ("CCCTA"), a joint exercise of powers agency created under California Government Code Section 6500 et seq., for the joint exercise of certain powers to provide coordinated and integrated public transportation services within the area of its Member Jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the CCCTA Board of Directors desires to support community based programs that provide or wish to provide transportation services to elderly and disabled persons in support of CCCTA goals and the goals of the community based programs; and

WHEREAS, CCCTA has surplus vans which have been replaced through the MTC Capital Priorities process that still maintain a useful life; and

WHEREAS, CCCTA has established guidelines to make these vans available to community based programs that provide both protection for CCCTA and opportunities for the community based organization that receives the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the provision of these vans to community based programs will ease the demand on LINK for service to some ADA eligible individuals and, at the same time, be available to provide transportation through the community based organization to other individuals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Central Contra Costa Transit Authority, that the General Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to implement a program to make surplus LINK vans available to community based programs in a manner that releases CCCTA from liability and also supports the use of the vehicle for the provision of transportation to ADA eligible individuals that might otherwise use LINK in a form approved by CCCTA Legal Counsel.


#### **Analysis**


Average weekday ridership in April (12,279 passengers) is consistent with the prior month of March (12,387 passengers), and higher than April of last year (11,217 passengers). See the attached table showing weekday boardings trend. Productivity in April was equal to 16.2 passengers per hour as compared to March's 16.1 passengers per hour.

The percentage of missed trips was lower in April (0.07%) as compared to the prior month of in March (0.13%). The YTD average is 0.11% missed trips.

The number of miles between roadcalls was equal to 38,118 miles in April which is higher than prior month of 29,173 miles in March. The year to date average is 37,654 miles between roadcalls.




