SUBJECT: Multi-Year Vehicle Procurement

SUMMARY OF ISSUES: The CCCTA follows the Federal Transit Administration (FTA)

guidelines regarding the procurement procedures for the purchase of new vehicles. In recent years, the FTA has nurtured the concept of multi-year bus procurement awards to reduce the administrative costs and delays involved in the single year procurement process. CCCTA has successfully undertaken and awarded a single multi-year

procurement contract for transit vehicles from a single manufacturer in

multiple configurations.

RECOMMENDATIONS: The CCCTA staff believes it to be in the best interest of the CCCTA to

publish, negotiate, and award a multi-year, multi-configuration Request for Proposal for the purchase of the Authority's planned bus purchases over the next 5-year period including options for expansion vehicles if

they are needed and funds become available.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: The cost of producing, advertising and awarding a single multi-year,

multi-configuration Request for Proposal would be no greater than a normal bid solicitation. The Authority would enjoy savings over the multi-year period by virtue of not needing to produce, advertise and award additional Request for Proposals saving in legal fees, advertising

fees and staff time.

ACTION REQUESTED: Direct staff to develop and award a multi-year Request for Proposal.
