# <u>Update on Extraordinary Session on Transportation</u>

General Manager Rick Ramacier explained that Senate Bill 824 is a clean up of the Cap and Trade legislation and includes all of the amendments CTA and CCCTA had proposed, but nothing else new to report due to no decision on where the funds will come from. As new developments come about he will continue to inform the Board.

Status of The California Air Resources Board (CARB) progress on updating requirements for public bus agencies to further reduce tailpipe emissions to near zero

General Manager Rick Ramacier informed the Board that he was going to attend a meeting next week to have discussions about zero emission buses and the cost in maintenance and electric cost associated with this. County Connection willdefinitely want to avoid service cuts and continue to keep track of all policy changes. He will continue to keep the Board informed as this matter develops.

Broad time frame for the Introduction of 4 All Electric Buses, partiially financed by the Federal Low or No Emissions Program

General Manager Rick Ramacier informed the Board that County Connection has been approved for a Low-No Grant program that allows the purchase of up to 4 All Electric Buses. We anticipate in the coming months bringing a series of studies that will help us decide where and how often these buses should operate.
