Administration and Finance Committee Summary Minutes October 1, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. at 1676 North California Blvd in Walnut Creek. Those in attendance were:

- 3. Approval of Minutes of September 11, 2019- Approved.
- 4. Income Statements for the Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2018 CFO Cheung reported that the actual expenses of \$37,974,668 are -3.8% (\$1,500,228) under budget for the fiscal year. Expenses are under budget due to vacancies and associated benefits; and lower promotions expense, legal services, liability costs, and diesel fuel costs. Finally, the contingency was not needed this fiscal year. Mr. Cheung also noted that fare revenues of \$5,049,538 are 9.8% above budget (\$451,286) with a fare box ratio of 14.3%. County Connection also received State Transit Assistance (STA) one-time revenues for \$956,000 that completed the old allocation method of STA Population based funds. The committee accepted the report and forwarded to the Board.
