SUBJECT: School Outreach

Background:

When area schools come back in session at the end of summer, County Connection staff will often attend registration and back-to-school events to promote Pass2Class, a county-wide program that provides passes for two months of free transit to enrolled students, as well as Youth Clipper Cards, which provides reduced transit fares for passengers between the ages of six and 18.

School Outreach:

Over the last two months, staff attended registration events seven schools where County Connection provides either regular fixed-route service or specialized 600-series school routes, including Diablo Valley College, St. Mary's College, California High School, Las Lomas High School, Monte Vista High School, Oak Grove Middle School, and Pine Hollow Middle School. In total, staff engaged with approximately 500 students and processed over 150 Youth Clipper Card applications.
